This past summer the Sugarloaf Ski Club launched a new initiative started with a generous \$500,000 gift from the H. King and Jean Cummings Charitable Fund. King & Jean Cummings strongly believed that everyone should have a chance to be a part of the sport that their family loved. This gift is the foundation of an endowment fund for the King's Kids initiative to help kids 15 and under in Franklin and Somerset counties learn to alpine ski, snowboard, and nordic ski, and to support other local initiatives.

## A King's Kid's Success Story

This past winter, over 60 kids from RSU 58, Stratton, and Rangeley enjoyed the Boomaugers program thanks to support by the King's Kids initiative. The King's Kids Endowment Fund underwrote 70 percent of the cost of this program.
